E-Week Transportation Luncheon

Chris Kauffmann, JAXPORT Chief Operation Officer (COO) will discuss the current state of the port and upcoming opportunities. He will also introduce Joe Miller, JAXPORT Senior Director, Facilities Development. Mr. Miller joined JAXPORT in January 2010 and will oversee JAXPORT's engineering and dredging projects under Mr. Kauffmann. Following the discussion there will be an informative Q&A session.

Chris Kauffmann, JAXPORT Chief Operating Officer (COO)

Chris Kauffmann joined JAXPORT as the Director of Seaport Security in 2002. In 2003 his responsibilities were expanded and he was named Senior Director, Terminal Operations and Seaport Security, responsible for all cargo operations and security requirements at the Talleyrand, Blount Island and Dames Point Marine Terminals. Last year he was promoted to JAXPORT's Chief Operating Officer, leading JAXPORT's cargo and cruise operations, security, administration and engineering

Kauffmann received a Bachelor of Science degree from Colorado State University in 1975. Before joining JAXPORT, he served in the United States Marine Corps in various command and staff positions for 28 years. He retired as a Colonel. While in the Marine Corps, he received a Masters in Business Administration from National University in 1982, and a Masters in National Military Strategy from the National Defense University in 1997.



Joe Miller, JAXPORT Senior Director, Facilities Development

Joe Miller is JAXPORT's newest team member, joining JAXPORT as Senior Director of Facilities Development in January of 2010. He has more than 30 years of leadership and management experience with complex organizations including the U.S. Army, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, and the City of Jacksonville. He spent 26 years in the Army. Assigned to the Headquarters, U.S Army Corps of Engineers in 1996, Joe was soon promoted to serve in Jacksonville as the District Engineer and Commander from 1997 through 2000. In this capacity, Joe led all federal civil works engineering and construction activities for Florida, Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands, supervising nearly one thousand employees and overseeing maintenance dredging operations for seven major port facilities and 700 miles of intracoastal waterways. Highlights of his tenure include the Everglades Restoration Program and the Hurricane Georges Emergency Recovery Operation in Puerto Rico.

From 2000 through 2002, Joe was the Director of Public Works for the City of Jacksonville then headed north to join Pennsylvania-based Weston Solutions, Inc., serving most recently as Army Business Program Manager.

Miller has a Master of Science in Engineering and Management.
